

# Papercraft KIT

## INGREDIENTS:

- crayons, markers, colored pencils, or watercolors
- scissors or x-acto blade & ruler
- scotch tape

## PRINTING INSTRUCTIONS

**LINEA CLASSIC:** Print in full color on thick 8.5x11" paper. Make sure to print at 100% (actual) size.

**CAFE BAR:** Print **DOUBLE-SIDED** in black & white on thick 8.5x11" paper. Make sure to print at 100% (actual) size, and make sure **TOP OF PRINT** lines up on both sides.

### LINEA CLASSIC

#### BEFORE YOU START:

Cut out all 3 pieces, **TOP**, **BASE**, and **BODY**; cutting on the **solid yellow lines**. Score\* along the **orange dotted lines**, then fold and crease the score lines using a blunt edge, like a butter knife or edge of a spoon.

**\*SCORING:** To "score" run a blunt edge, like a butter knife, along the dotted line to indent the paper, but don't press hard enough to cut through.

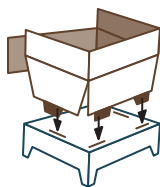
**TIP:** Use scissors to pre-cut small strips of scotch tape before constructing your Linea Classic. You will need 9 pieces, and they should be about this size.

#### STEP 1: Construct the TOP.

Tuck **RED TABS A B C** and **D** behind each corner and use tape to secure the corners. All colored tabs should be hidden when machine is fully constructed. The finished piece should look like a box.

#### STEP 2: Construct the BASE.

Tuck **BLUE TABS E F G** and **H** behind each corner and use tape to secure the corners. Tuck in the colored tabs of the legs. The finished piece should look like a box on legs.

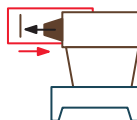
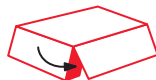
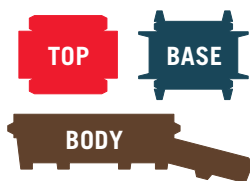


**STEP 3:** Take the **BODY** piece, and insert **BROWN TABS I J K L** and **M** into their corresponding slots of the **BASE** (starting with **I** and moving around the base, finishing with **M**). Finally, tuck **BROWN TAB N** on the front panel of the body, behind its corner and use tape to secure it in place.

**\*TIP:** Pull the tabs downward from underneath the **BASE**, then twist to lock them into place.

#### STEP 4: Put it all together!

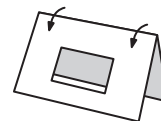
Take the **BODY** piece and tuck **BROWN TABS O** and **P** into their corresponding **SLOTS Q** and **P** of the **TOP** piece.



### CAFE BAR

#### STEP 1:

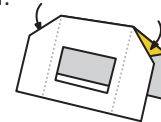
Color the card **EXTERIOR** and **INTERIOR** using crayons, markers, colored pencils, or watercolors. Once you are finished, cut along the **dashed lines**, then fold the card in half and crease.



#### STEP 2:

On the Holiday Card **INTERIOR**, score\* along the **dotted lines**. On the card **EXTERIOR**, turn the **dotted lines** inward to create a [concave] valley-fold.

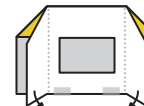
Crease along the folds using a blunt edge, like a butter knife or edge of a spoon.



**\*SCORING:** To "score" run a blunt edge, like a butter knife, along the dotted line to indent the paper, but don't press hard enough to cut through.

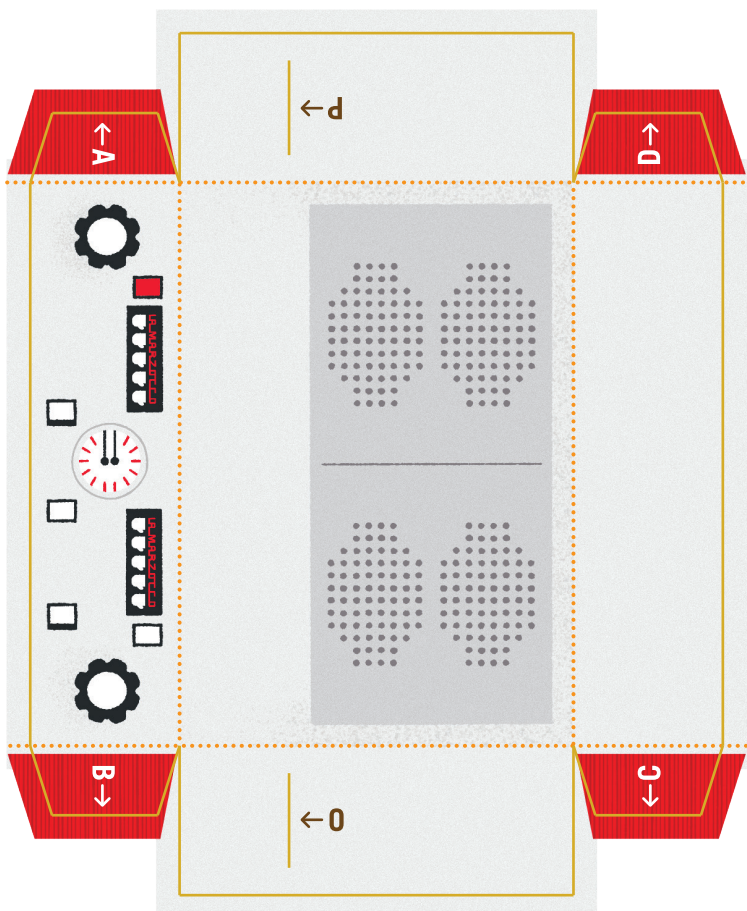
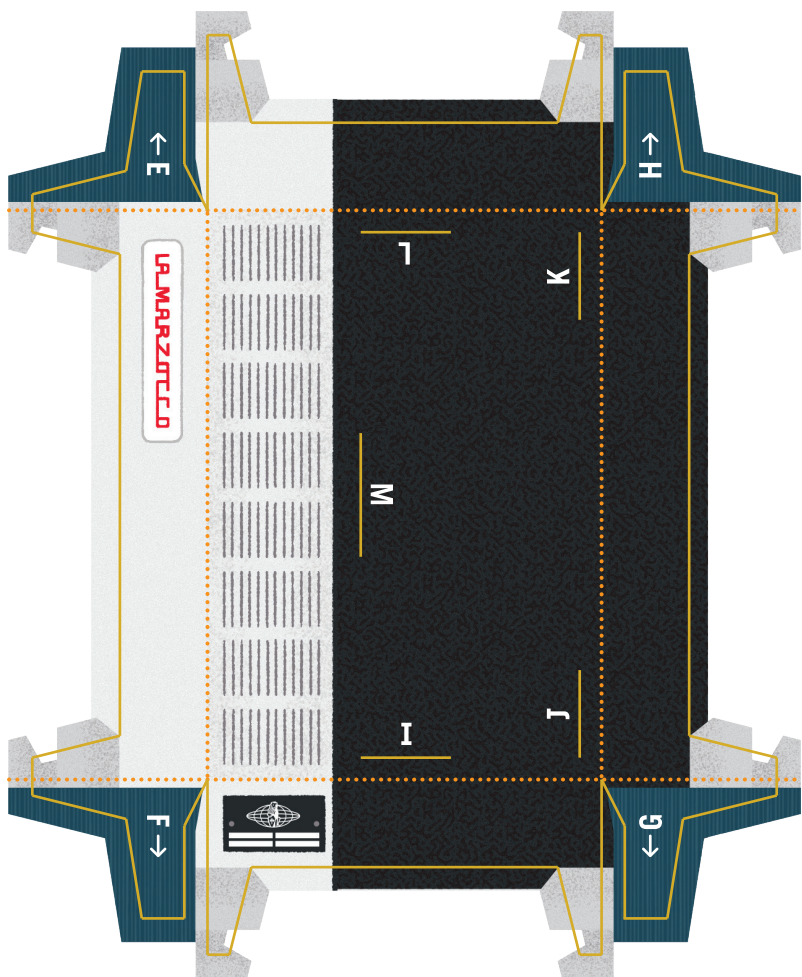
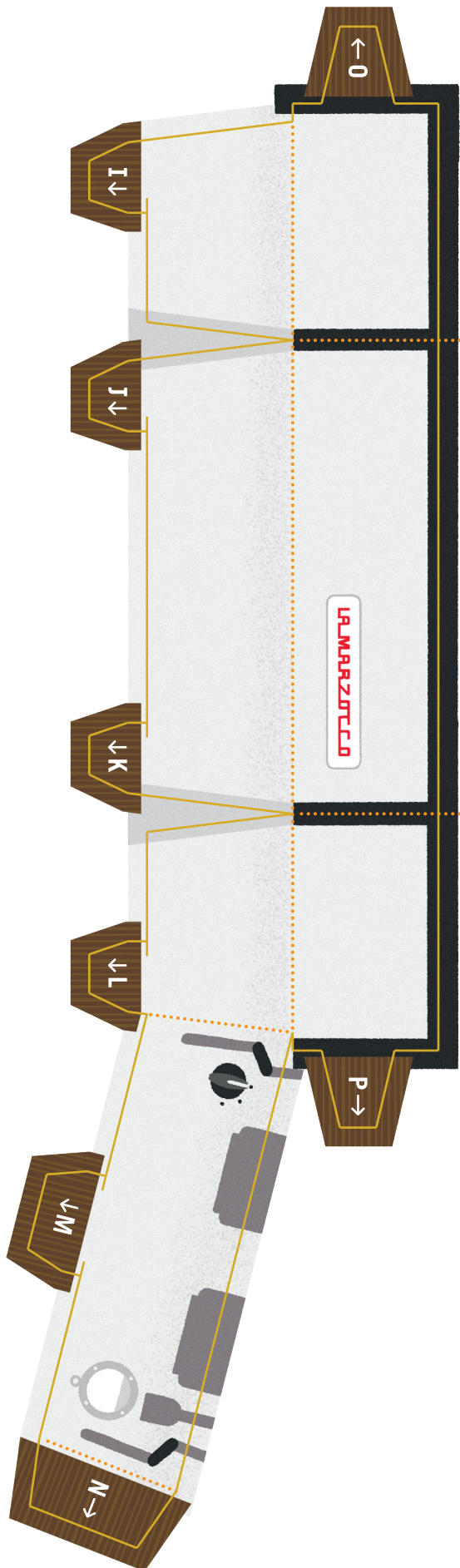
**STEP 3:** With the front of the card facing you, fold the side flaps toward you. Crease the folds, then swing the flaps back out so they are at a 90° or 60° angle.

Prop the card upright and place your Linea Classic on the bar!



**TIP:** Secure the bottom of the card with small pieces of scotch tape.

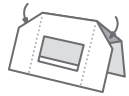

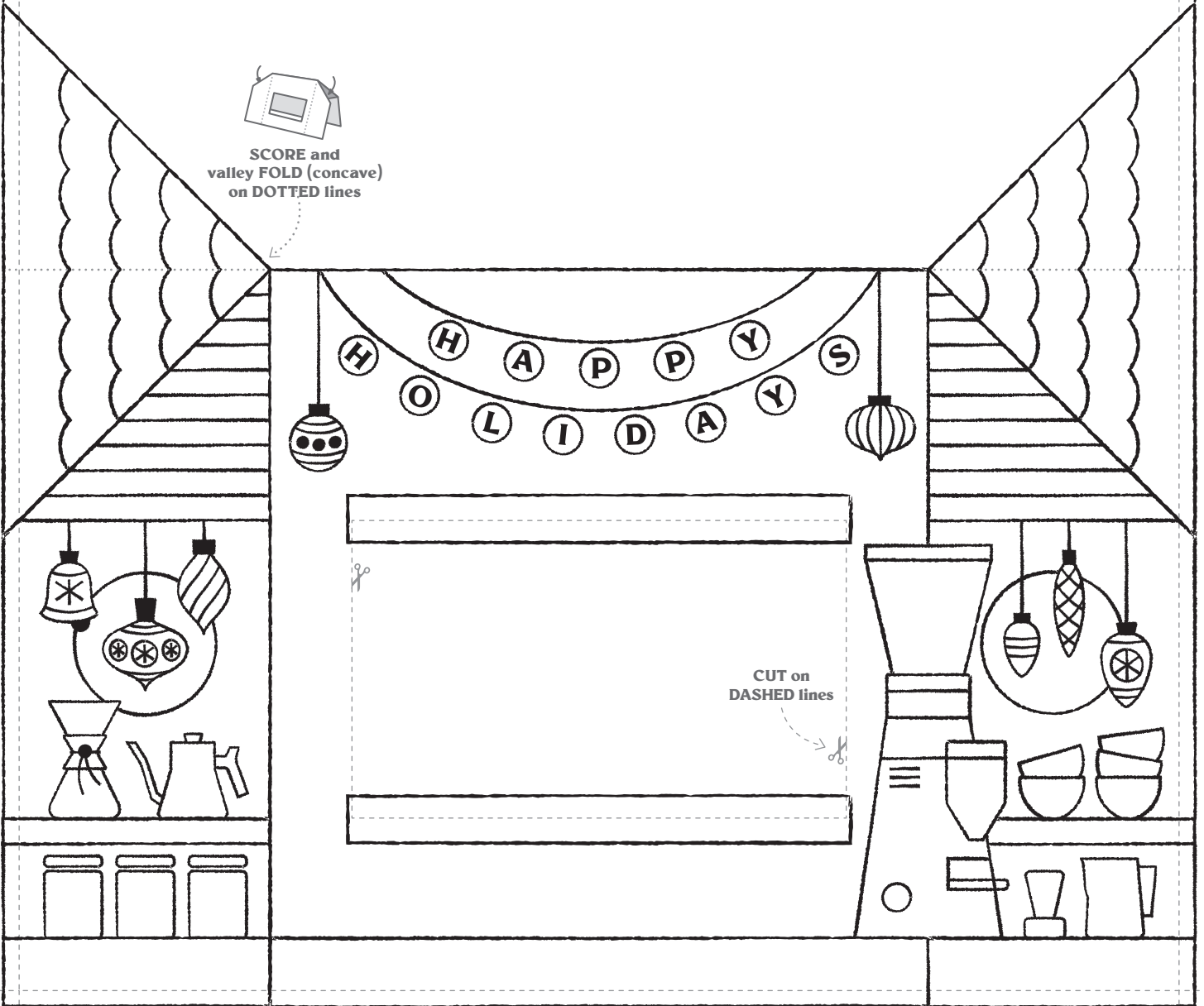
